ASH WEDNESDAY

The Spirit urges us into the desert discipline of the Lenten Season. For 40 days we will strip away everything that separates us from God, beginning today, as we are marked a cross of ashes: death and life in a single sign! Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence.

Fast and Abstinence in Canada

The Church prescribes fasting (only one full meal and two smaller meals which together are not greater than a full meal) and abstinence from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Catholics aged 18-59 are bound to fast; those 14-59 to abstinence. Those who are ill are freed from these obligations; all, even above the age of 59 may continue to fast and abstain.

Parents and educators are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding and practice of penance. Adult example will be the greatest influence in this matter.

LENT: DAYS OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

All Catholics are encouraged to take up the practice of fasting during the Lenten Season. This can include giving up something for the 40 days of Lent, taking up the Wednesday and Friday fast in which we make a special commitment to fast during those days, choosing some form of sacrifice, etc. The Fridays of Lent are also a time to observe abstinence from meat. Although this practice is recommended to all Catholics throughout the year, it is particularly important during Lent as we prepare to honor the Lord's crucifixion on Good Friday. We join ourselves to his suffering in a small way and offer our abstinence the salvation of souls.

SPECIAL COLLECTION: Diocesan and Missionary Works on the weekend of **March 1** the First Sunday of Lent. This collection enables the Archdiocese of Ottawa to assist Canadian dioceses, other catholic organizations such as Campaign Life, and National March for Life.
