**March 5<sup>th</sup>, Ash Wednesday and the Beginning of Lent**

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the Season of Lent. It is a season of penance, reflection, and fasting which prepares us for Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday. It is important to remember that Ash Wednesday itself is a day of penitential prayer and fasting. It is generally inappropriate to dine out, to shop, or to go about in public after receiving the ashes. It is not required that a person wear the ashes for the rest of the day, they may be washed off after Mass. However, many people keep the ashes as a reminder until the evening.
