Palm Sunday – Jesus’ Entrance into Jerusalem

What do Palm Branches Represent?

Palm branches have a significant meaning. People didn’t just grab whatever leaves they could find. The branches of the Palm tree are a symbol of the victory and triumph Jesus has over death. (Revelation 7:9) The branches of the palm tree with

it’s feathery, pale-green leaves can be 6 to 12 feet long and they attract the eye wherever they are seen. The Jewish People wanted victory, victory over the Romans who had invaded their land. Jesus did come to enact a victory, but not quite the one they had in mind.

When we use palm branches on Passion Sunday, we remember how Jesus conquered death for us and that through His sacrifice, we all have a chance of eternal salvation.

And why a Donkey? Zechariah 9:9 “Righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey”. In ancient times, rulers rode horses into battle, but a donkey symbolized peace. Jesus did not come as a warrior but came as a King reflecting peace, humility and servant-hood, bringing salvation to all the world.
