## January: Dedicated to the Holy Name of Jesus

## **Pope Leo XIV has proclaimed a special Franciscan Jubilee Year**

*From January 10, 2026 to January 10, 2027*

This Jubilee Year is a time for all Christians to follow the example of St. Francis, becoming models of holiness and constant witnesses of peace.

The Vatican expressed hope that this Jubilee will inspire renewed charity, peace, and evangelical witness, transforming the fruits of the Holy Year into concrete works of love in today's world.

The Apostolic Penitentiary has granted a **Plenary Indulgence**: to those who participate devoutly, under the usual conditions.

**Pilgrimage Requirements:** Devout participation at a Franciscan conventual church or site connected to St. Francis, including the recitation of the Creed, the Lord's Prayer, and prayers for the Holy Father.

**Spiritual Access:** The elderly, sick, or those unable to travel may obtain the indulgence by spiritually joining the Jubilee and offering their sufferings to God

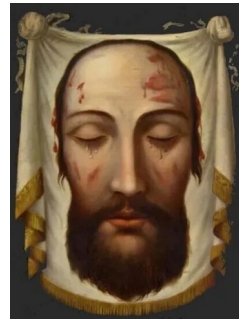
