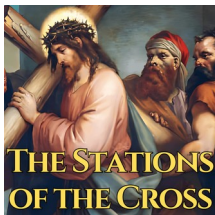

March: Dedicated to St Joseph

After the Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Joseph is the greatest of the saints. He is the one “into whose custody God entrusted his most precious treasures,” Jesus and Mary.

Everything we know about the husband of Mary and the foster father of Jesus comes from Scripture and that has seemed too little.

We know he was a carpenter, a working man. "Is this not the carpenter's son?" (Matthew 13:55). He wasn't rich for he offered the sacrifice of two turtledoves or a pair of pigeons, allowed only for those who could not afford a lamb (Luke 2:24). Despite his humble work and means, Joseph

came from a royal lineage.

May 1st - St Joseph the Worker (Memorial)

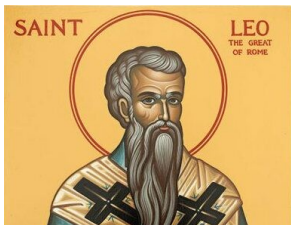
Prayer:

Vinegar & Gall – A weapon used in the Crucifixion



The Romans used Vinegar to revive those who fainted during their crucifixion so that they would continue to feel the pain.

In the case of Our Lord, who had not fainted, the vinegar was offered in mockery. This additional suffering, He did not refuse. By His example, He teaches us how we ought to accept the sufferings which Providence permits others to inflict upon us. He also show us the importance of mortifying our sense of taste.

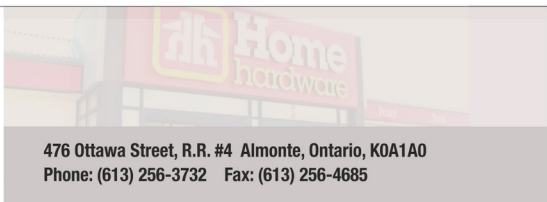
