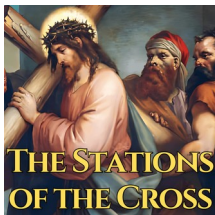

The world instinctively flees from pain and suffering, but as children of God we learn to accept it and even treasure the cross, as it is our means of salvation.

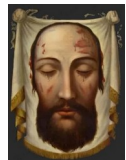
Let us always make the Sign of the Cross with great reverence and care. And let us pray and make reparation for all who despise and revile the Holy Cross.

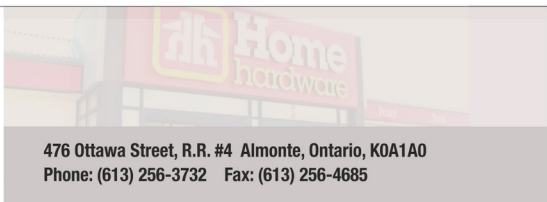
