THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST



Today we joyfully proclaim our faith in the real presence of Our Lord in the most Holy Eucharist. On Holy Thursday we celebrate the institution of the Eucharist, but on account of the nearness to Good Friday, the Church restrains its joy, waiting until the Thursday after the Feast of the Holy Trinity (or the Sunday following as in Canada) to give expression to sentiments of joy and gratitude in response to the mystery of Our Lord's presence in the Most Holy Eucharist.

One of the important ways in which to honour Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament is an outdoor Eucharistic Procession. This allows for a public profession of our faith that Christ is really, truly and substantially present in the Eucharist; it also affords a public reparation of all the injuries, irreverence and offences which have been and are committed against Christ in the Blessed Sacrament; it provides for a solemn veneration and adoration due to the Son of God in this Sacrament in thanksgiving for its institution and for all the graces and advantages received; and finally, to invoke the divine blessing upon God's people, upon our nation and upon the world.

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE SACRED HEART

On the Friday following today's feast the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart. This feast celebrates the love of God manifested in the heart of Jesus, the Source and center of God's love made flesh among us. The readings for Mass speak of God's personal love for each of us in Christ, "seeking us out, going in search" of the wayward, to bring all of us back, healed, reconciled and made at peace. It is another form of Good Friday's proclamation that we are loved by God not after we repented but "while we were still sinners." Devotion to the Sacred Heart should lead us to seek that "enlargement of heart" which will kindle in us the fire of Christ's own charity, and to make reparation for our own sins and those of all the human family that have wounded the heart of Christ.
