First Friday of the month, March 4th – Holy Mass at 9:00 am, St. Peter Celestine Church, Pakenham

First Saturday of the month, March 5th– Holy Mass at 8:00 am (no Adoration after Mass), St. Michael’s, Carp

First Friday overnight Adoration at St. Michael Church

Adoration will begin on Friday, March 4th, at 7 pm and continue through the night until 8 am on First Saturday, March 5th. First Saturday Mass will start at 8 am. There will not be Adoration after this Mass.

You are welcome to sign up for any hour of Adoration from 7pm on Friday until 8 am on Saturday. In addition to the "prayer hours" there will be a requirement to change out candles and monitor the safety of the burning candles throughout the night. Please consider adopting more than one hour (IE two in a row) especially in the wee hours of the night. This effort is going to require Parish-wide support. 
