AUGUST- The Month of The Immaculate Heart of Mary

The month of August is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Since the 16th century Catholic piety has assigned entire months to special devotions. The month of August is traditionally dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The physical heart of Mary is venerated (and not adored as the Sacred Heart of Jesus is) because it is united to her person and is the seat of her love (especially for her divine Son), virtue, and inner life. Such devotion is an incentive to a similar love and virtue.

Sunday August 20: Our annual **Cemetery Service** will be held at 2:30 pm at St. Peter Celestine Cemetery on Indian Hill Road. A collection will be taken up at the service to cover the cost of maintenance and upkeep of the cemetery property. Envelopes have been placed at the back of the church for anyone who may wish to receive an income tax receipt for their donation. Please be as generous as you can. In the event of rain, the

cemetery service will be held in the church.

August 22: Feast of the Queenship of The Blessed Virgin Mary: The coronation and enthronement ceremony of Our Lady as Queen of our parish and families will be held at both parishes next weekend- after Mass on Sat Aug 26 and Sunday Aug 27 at St. Michael and after Mass on **Sunday Aug 27** at St. Peter Celestine.

Catholics celebrate the Queenship of Mary because her Divine Son is King. Pope Pius XII, having declared the dogma of the Assumption, that “the Immaculate Mother of God .was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory,” then established the feast of her Queenship. He set the date for the octave (8th day) after the Solemnity of the Assumption, that is, August 22nd each year.

In his encyclical Ad Caeli Reginam, the Pope proclaimed,

“We are instituting a feast so that all may recognize more clearly and venerate more devoutly the merciful and maternal sway of the Mother of God. We are convinced that this feast will help to preserve, strengthen and prolong that peace among nations which daily is almost destroyed by recurring crises. Is she not a rainbow in the clouds reaching towards God, the pledge of a covenant of peace?”
