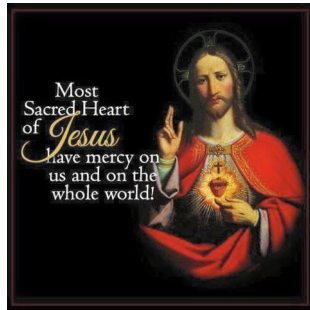

**JUNE – THE MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS**

In the Catholic Church, the month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This great feast in the Church is always celebrated on the octave day of Corpus Christi, the feast which celebrates the Body and Blood of Christ. Corpus Christi falls on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday (which itself falls on the Sunday after Pentecost), which means the feast of the Sacred Heart falls nineteen days after Pentecost Sunday. In 1672, Christ appeared to a French Visitation nun, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. Over a series of visits, Our Lord revealed to St. Margaret Mary the importance of devotion to His Sacred Heart. He asked that His heart, wounded on the cross and

continually wounded by ingratitude of men for his sacrifice for them, be venerated and adored as an embodiment of His Divine mercy and love. Jesus especially asked that all people go to Confession and receive Holy Communion often, especially on the First Friday of each month, and that reparation be made for sins committed against His Sacred Heart and the Holy Eucharist.

**MEMORIAL OF SAINT ALOYSIUS GONZAGA - JUNE 21**

St. Aloysius Gonzaga's outstanding quality was his radiant purity and the Church praises this perfect innocence with the words, "Thou has made him little less than the angels." He was baptized in the womb, because his life was in danger, and he made a vow of chastity at the age of nine. When he was sixteen, he joined the Society of Jesus and died at the age of twenty-three in 1591 as a result of his devoted nursing of the plague-stricken.

**THE CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD PROGRAM (CGS)**

The program has just wrapped up for the year. This is a time-tested approach to faith formation. It feeds the deepest needs of children, allowing each one to get to know God personally. In a retreat-like atmosphere, through the use of special materials designed just for them, children hear the Word proclaimed and grow in their relationship with God. This year, the Atrium at St. Joseph's house, right beside Holy Spirit Parish, welcomed 8 children. Some will be back, but we're also hoping new children will join. And although he was not prompted, it's unlikely this would have occurred outside the CGS environment, where everything is meant to stir the Holy Spirit within the child. CGS has a need for growth within this program and that's why Ottawa will once again play host to a training program for catechists this summer.
