May – Month of the Virgin Mary, Mother of God

The May devotion [to our Lady] in its present form originated at Rome where Father Latomia of the Roman College of the Society of Jesus, to counteract infidelity and immorality among the students, made a vow at the end of the eighteenth century to devote the month of May to Mary. From Rome the practice spread to the other Jesuit colleges and thence to nearly every Catholic church of the Latin rite. This practice is the oldest instance of a devotion extending over an entire month.

Solemnity of the Ascension or the Seventh Sunday of Easter – May 12

At the end of His earthly life Jesus ascends triumphantly into Heaven. The Church acclaim Him in His holy humanity, invited to sit on the Father's right hand and to share His glory. But Christ's Ascension is the pledge of our own. Filled with an immense hope, the Church looks up towards her leader, who precedes her into the heavenly home and takes her with Him in His own person: "for the Son of God, after incorporating in Himself those whom the devil's jealousy had banished from the earthly paradise, ascends again to His Father and takes them with Him" (St. Leo).

Mothers' Day – May 12

"That special power of loving that belongs to a woman is seen most clearly when she becomes a mother. Motherhood is the gift of God to women. How grateful we must be to God for this wonderful gift that brings such joy to the whole world, women and men alike!" St. Teresa of Calcutta.

Feast of St. Peter Celestine – May 19

He was born in 1215 in the village of Santangelo Limosano, in Molise (near Isernia), the son of Angelo Angelerio and Maria Leone. He was the eleventh of the twelve children of a family described as "poor but honest, deeply religious peasants". Humility raised this Saint above the world, and preserved his soul free from its poison, both amidst its flatteries and under its frown. On July 7th, 1294, Pietro (Pope Celestine V), the 194th Pope was elected.

He resigned on December 13, 1294.

No subsequent Pope has taken the name Celestine.
